The advertised regular monthly meeting of the Latimore Township Park Board was held on June 2, 2010 at the Latimore Township Park, 711 Pond Town Road, York Springs, PA 17372. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Woody Myers.

Old Business:

1. Grant – The walking trail has been completed, but berms still need to be seeded. The DCNR inspector also pointed out that the wood chips at the top of the playground are too big, and need to be raked off. Low spots also need to be filled in. Once the work has been done, photos can be submitted instead of another on-site inspection. He remarked on the absence of a border between the sod and the wood chips. The park board was told it was optional, and actually not recommended, as it is a tripping hazard. FPE is working with DCNR about this issue.

New Business:

1. Chairman Myers presented Mark and Lynn Schoppaul with a plaque from the Township and Park Board in appreciation of their time and dedication to the improvement of the park.

Bills List: Motion to pay the bills list by Robert Garlin, 2nd by Joseph Reeve, passed.

Public Participation: A representative from the soccer league informed the board that they would like to use the baseball outfield in the fall as well as the multi-purpose field they currently use. Their spring season ends June 5th and the fall season starts the 3rd week of August. Also, there will be a summer soccer camp July 12-16th. They also let the board know that the national association now requires all local associations to send any contracts they sign to National for approval. Because of this, the reservation forms for the summer and fall field requests may not be turned in as quickly as they would like. All insurance forms are provided by the national association as well.
