The advertised regular monthly meeting of the Latimore Township Park Board was held on September 2, 2009 at the Latimore Township Park at 711 Pond Town Road. York Springs, PA 17372. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Woody Myers.

Pledge of Allegiance

In Attendance: Chairman Woody Myers, Field Maintenance Robert Garlin, Member Joseph Reeve, Vice Chairman Mark Schoppaul and Secretary/Financial Lynn Schoppaul.

Absent: League Facilitator Michael Patterson and Member Casey Coble.

Minutes of the July 1st, 2009 meeting were approved as read. There was no meeting in August, due to no quorum.

Old Business:

1. Mike Weigand memorial – A memorial service will be held September 12, 2009 at 10:00 AM, at the park. A tree has been planted and a monument at the base of the tree will be unveiled at the end of the service.
2. Fencing – The 3-rail split rail fence has been installed along the road. Buzzy Baker, the “Guru of Fencing” at the Gettysburg National Battlefield assisted Park Board members with his expertise and hard work to get the fence installed on Saturday, July 25th. His help was most appreciated.
3. Walking trail – Cindy at FPE has been working with Beth at DCNR and has provided DCNR with documentation of the changes to the trail layout and materials. The base will be 4” of PA 2A stone, topped with 2” of Trail Mix. The altered plans have been approved by Beth at DCNR. The township has made a proposal for the road crew do the work on the trail and be reimbursed by the Park Board. A motion Joseph Reeve, 2nd Mark Schoppaul, to accept the proposal, passed.
4. Pavillion Rentals – A motion by Robert Garlin, 2nd by Mark Schoppaul, to return deposits to the renters of the pavilion in the past month, passed.
5. Playground – The playground walkway, handicap parking and driveway to the shed have been tarred and chipped. The benches have been installed.

New Business:

1. The Pavillion is rented on two dates in September, the 20th & the 27th.
2. Lynn Schoppaul is preparing the packet to be sent to DCNR for the partial disbursement.
3. Mark Schoppaul spoke to Mike Weigand about barriers to prevent vehicles from driving on the trails. Chief Weigand will talk to a contact about possibly donating the materials for pipe barriers.
4. Friday, September 11th, will be a work night at the park to clean up the pavilion., starting at 6:30 PM.

Bills List: A motion by Joseph Reeve, 2nd by Robert Garlin, to pay the bills, passed.

Public Participation: Pasha Kaufman, of AYSO, informed the board that opening day for soccer is September 12th, the day of the Memorial for Mike Weigand. They will stop the soccer games for the duration of the service. The league will be holding a food drive, and donating the goods received to the food pantry at a York Springs church. The Park Board will post a document provided by Pasha, on the Park page of the township website. Their league picnic will be held on October 24th. The next board meeting will be held at the park pavilion September 20th at 6:00 PM and the board members are invited.

The gentleman who owns the house behind the park asked about the plans for the walking trail. He was concerned about how close to the property line the trail will be. The chairman will check with the engineers to be sure the required distances are met.

Next regular meeting: October 7th, 2009 at the Park.
