Regular Meeting
April 10, 2017; 6:00 PM

Present: Chairman Daniel Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Secretary Megan Colby, Solicitor Guy Beneventano, Chief Michael Weigand, and visitors listed on attendance sheet.

Chairman Dan Worley called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the Minutes of the March 13, 2017, Regular Meeting and to approve the Treasurer's Report of March 31, 2017. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael E. Weigand gave the police report for March 12, 2017, through April 8, 2017. There were 146 calls for service, 3211 miles patrolled, 318.25 duty hours, 49 traffic citations, and 7 traffic warnings.

Chief Weigand explained that the Police Department had joined with PA State Police the previous weekend for a traffic enforcement detail along US Rt 15 and had issued a number of traffic citations.

He also reminded residents of the Drug Take Back program that will take place on April 29, 2017, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the Bermudian Springs School District.

Chief Weigand then respectfully requested the Board of Supervisors' approval of the Police Department's naloxone policy. He explained that opioid overdose was one of the leading causes of accidental death in Adams County and Central PA and that the Adams County District Attorney's Office would be providing the naloxone to the Police Department. He also requested that Officer Terry DeWitt be recognized as the manager of the naloxone for this agency. He stated that naloxone had been a part of the annual training held recently and that all officers were required to complete online training before carrying naloxone. Dan Worley made a motion to approve the naloxone policy and appoint Officer DeWitt as the manager of such, and the motion carried unanimously.

Chief Weigand respectfully requested the Board of Supervisors' reappointment of Officer Burnell Bevenour as a part-time officer in the Latimore Township Police Department. He noted that Officer Bevenour had previously served with this agency and that the uniform and equipment issued to him were still available. Dan Worley made a motion to appoint Officer Burnell Bevenour as a part-time officer with the Police Department, and Woody Myers seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Chief Weigand then announced the 5K event at Greist Park on April 15, 2017, and the Make a Wish truck convoy on May 7, 2017.

Engineer's Report: None

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that the road crew has been doing some patching work and general maintenance on the roads.

Park Report: Woody Myers reported that due to the wet weather recently there has not been much activity at the park and that the soccer club has had to cancel a few practices and games.

Solicitor's Report: Solicitor Guy Beneventano reported that the Township had taken enforcement action against Mr. and Mrs. Talton of 114 Old US Route 15 and the Apex Bank that owns the property due to violation of the zoning ordinance. He indicated the neither the Taltons nor the Apex Bank had appealed the zoning violation in the time required by law, and he made a recommendation to the Board to authorize the Zoning Officer John Shambaugh to file a civil complaint against Mr. and Mrs. Talton and Apex Bank before Magisterial District Judge Tony Little. Dan Worley made a motion to authorize Zoning Officer John Shambaugh to proceed as described, and Larry Dost seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Hershey Stormwater Management Plan

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the Hershey Stormwater Management Plan, upon condition of payment of all outstanding engineering fees. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Advertise Road and Stone Bids

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the advertisement of the bids for road work and stone. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Lake Meade Fire and Ambulance Service Contracts

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the service contracts for the Lake Meade Fire Department and Ambulance. Larry Dost seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

BILLS LIST

Larry Dost reported that he had reviewed the bills list and recommended that it be approved as submitted. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.
