Regular Meeting
July 11, 2016; 6:00 PM

Present: Chairman Daniel Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Secretary Megan Colby, Chief Michael Weigand, and visitors listed on the attendance sheet.

Chairman Daniel Worley called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the Minutes of the June 13, 2016, Regular Meeting and to approve the Treasurer's Report of June 30, 2016. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT (1)

Residents Geoff Clymer and Steve VanVoorhees (of Lake Meade Road) were present to ask the Board and Police Chief about speed enforcement on Lake Meade Road. Mr. Clymer's property was damaged recently when a drunk driver went through his fence, and he and his neighbor were concerned about drivers exceeding the 35mph speed limit on that road. Mr. Clymer had three questions to ask the Board and Chief Weigand: Is there a possibility of speed enforcement on Lake Meade Road?, If not, or in addition to the enforcement, could a speed enforcement sign be placed on the road?, and Would it be possible to post a 'No Brake Retarder' sign along that road?

Chief Weigand addressed the matters of speed enforcement and a corresponding sign. He explained that there were a lot of police hours going into investigations and speed enforcement in high crash areas, and such issues took priority. He also explained that speed enforcement signs are very expensive and that they do have Vascar lines along Lake Meade Road to encourage drivers to adhere to the speed limit. He stated that he would speak to PennDOT to see if there was an available sign that could be loaned to the Township.

Chief Weigand also mentioned that since Lake Meade Road is a state road, it would be PennDOT's responsibility to post a 'No Brake Retarder' sign. However, he stated that the management at Growmark, where most of the trucks are going to or leaving from, was dedicated to being neighborly, and that he would speak to management about asking the company truck drivers to limit the use of brake retarders.

Mr. Clymer stated that he also wanted to express his thanks to the Latimore Township Police Department for being so supportive, responsive, and professional.

The Board of Supervisors expressed thanks to Mr. Clymer and Mr. VanVoorhees for attending the meeting.

REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael E. Weigand gave the police report for June 11, 2016, through July 10, 2016. There were 164 calls for service, 3232 miles patrolled, 283.5 duty hours, 9 traffic citations, and 7 traffic warnings.

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that Blackberry School Road and Bonners Hill Road had been seal coated and levelled, and Brough Road, Bushey School Road, and Baltimore Road had also been seal coated.
